Agreement of Voluntary Surrender of License

Whereas, on November 16, 2017, the Kentucky Board of Physical Therapy ("Board") approved a Settlement Agreement with Steve Shepherd, PT, 101 Lakepointe Dr, Albany, KY 42602 ("Respondent") for multiple violations of KRS 327.070(2)(h) and 327.070(2)(k);

Whereas, the Settlement Agreement incorporated fifteen (15) terms including, but not limited to, suspension of his license for sixty (60) days; probation for five (5) years; \$10,000.00 fine; and completion of specific continuing competency programs; and

Whereas, Respondent desires to voluntarily surrender his license to practice as a physical therapist in the Commonwealth of Kentucky;

It is hereby stipulated and agreed between the undersigned parties the following terms:

Voluntary Waiver of Rights

The Respondent has had the opportunity at all times to seek the advice from competent counsel of choice. No coercion has been exerted upon the Respondent, nor have

any promises been made other than those reflected in this Agreement. The Respondent freely and voluntarily enters into this Agreement, motivated only by a desire to resolve the issues addressed herein. The Respondent has executed this Agreement only after a careful reading of it and a full understanding of all of its terms. The Respondent waives the right to challenge any agreed upon term or condition of this Agreement notwithstanding any other statutory provision of KRS Chapter 327, and the Respondent expressly agrees those agreed upon terms and conditions contained therein are exclusively a matter of private right.

The Respondent is fully aware of the rights to contest charges in a formal hearing. These rights include: representation by an attorney at the Respondent's own expense, the right to a public hearing on charges contained in any Notice of Administrative Hearing, the right to confront and cross-examine witnesses called to testify against the Respondent, the right to present evidence on the Respondent's behalf, the right to compulsory process to secure the attendance of such witnesses, the right to testify on the Respondent's own behalf, the right to receive written findings of fact and conclusions of law supporting the decision on the merits of a Notice of Administrative Hearing, the right to obtain judicial review of the Board's decision, and the right to appeal any Final Order of the Board to the Franklin Circuit Court as otherwise allowed by KRS 327.075(4). All of these rights are being voluntarily waived by the Respondent in exchange for the Board's acceptance of this Agreement.

Jurisdiction

The Respondent acknowledges the Board has jurisdiction over the Respondent and the conduct which has precipitated this Agreement. The Respondent also acknowledges the Board has the legal power to take disciplinary action up to and including revocation of the Respondent's license to practice as a physical therapist in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Respondent acknowledges the Board will retain jurisdiction over this matter until all terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement have been met to the satisfaction of the Board.

Publication of Settlement Agreement

The Respondent acknowledges, once adopted by the Board, this Agreement is considered a public document, available for inspection at any time by any member of the public under the Kentucky Open Records Act. Further, the Respondent understands the Board is free to make any use it deems appropriate of the contents of this Agreement, which shall include the Board's ability to share the content of this Agreement with any governmental or professional Board or organization, publication of a summary in the Board's newsletter and availability via the Board's website, and reporting under federal law.

Effect upon License Status: Voluntary Surrender of License

The parties agree to the following as the agreed upon disciplinary action:

1. The Respondent's license to practice as a physical therapist in the Commonwealth of Kentucky shall be voluntarily surrendered as if suspended upon a filing of an Order of the Board adopting this Agreement.

2. All terms of the November 16, 2017 Settlement Agreement shall be held in abeyance during the period of voluntary surrender.
3. Should Respondent seek reinstatement of his license, any elapsed time between entry of this Agreement and reinstatement of his license shall not count towards the suspension, probation, monitoring, or restrictions on practice set forth in the November 16, 2017 Settlement Agreement.

Reinstatement Provision

The Respondent may apply for reinstatement of his license pursuant to the provisions of KRS 327.075 and 201 KAR 22:040, no sooner than sixty (60) days from the date of the filing of an Order of the Board adopting this Agreement so long as:

- a. The Respondent has paid all fines assessed under the November 16, 2017 Settlement Agreement.
- b. The Respondent has completed all continuing competency courses mandated by the November 16, 2017 Settlement Agreement.

Duty to Cooperate with the Board

The Respondent agrees to permit and cooperate with the Board, its members, agents, and employees, to monitor the Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

The Respondent agrees to indemnify the Board for any costs, including reasonable attorney's fees, if the Board finds, after notice and opportunity to be heard, that the Respondent has failed to comply with any provision of this Agreement.

Release of Liability

In consideration of execution of this Agreement, the Respondent, the Respondent's executors, administrators, successors and assigns, hereby releases and forever discharges the Commonwealth of Kentucky, the Kentucky Board of Physical Therapy, and each of their members, former members, agents, and employees in their individual and representative

capacities, from any and all manner of actions, causes of action, suits, debts, judgments, executions, claims and demands whatsoever, known and unknown, in law or equity, the Respondent ever had, now has, may have or claim to have against any or all of the persons or entities named in this paragraph arising out of or by reason of this investigation, this disciplinary action, this Agreement, or its administration.

Acceptance by the Board

It is hereby agreed between the parties this Agreement shall be presented to the Kentucky Board of Physical Therapy at the next regularly-scheduled meeting of the Board.

The Respondent understands the Board is free to accept or reject this Agreement. The Respondent hereby agrees to waive any right the Respondent might have to challenge the impartiality of the Board, based solely upon the presentation of this Agreement if, after review by the Board, this Agreement is rejected.

If the Agreement is not accepted by the Board, it shall be regarded as null and void. Admissions by the Respondent in the Agreement will not be regarded as evidence against the Respondent at a subsequent disciplinary hearing. The Respondent will be free to defend and no inferences against the Respondent will be made from the Respondent's willingness to have entered into this Agreement.

The Agreement shall not become effective until it has been approved by a majority of the Board and endorsed by a representative member of the Board.

Complete Agreement

This Agreement consists of seven (7) pages and embodies the entire agreement between the Board and the Respondent. This Agreement shall constitute a binding

contract between the Respondent and the Board, subject only to approval by the Board as set forth above. The Respondent shall not rescind, revoke, withdraw, or request to modify this Agreement prior to or during its presentation to the Board at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board. It may not be altered, amended or modified without the express written consent of both parties.
